**IMPORTANT** – We encourage foreign participants to apply for their visas as early as possible, we are recommending to do so at least **three to four months before the Conference**. Some consulates may have backlogs in scheduling visa interviews. Therefore, applicants should first consult the U.S. Department of State's [visa appointment and processing wait times website](#).

The International Visitors Office assists international students, scholars, and other travelers who are coming to the United States for scientific purposes. ## **How to Enter the United States**

### **Procedures for Entering the United States**

When you arrive in the United States, you must show valid travel documents as part of the [entry process](#). The documents you need and [whether your passport needs to be valid for six months after your travel dates](#) depend on the country you are arriving from and your citizenship or status.

Foreign nationals [must be fully vaccinated against COVID-19](#) before entering the U.S.
